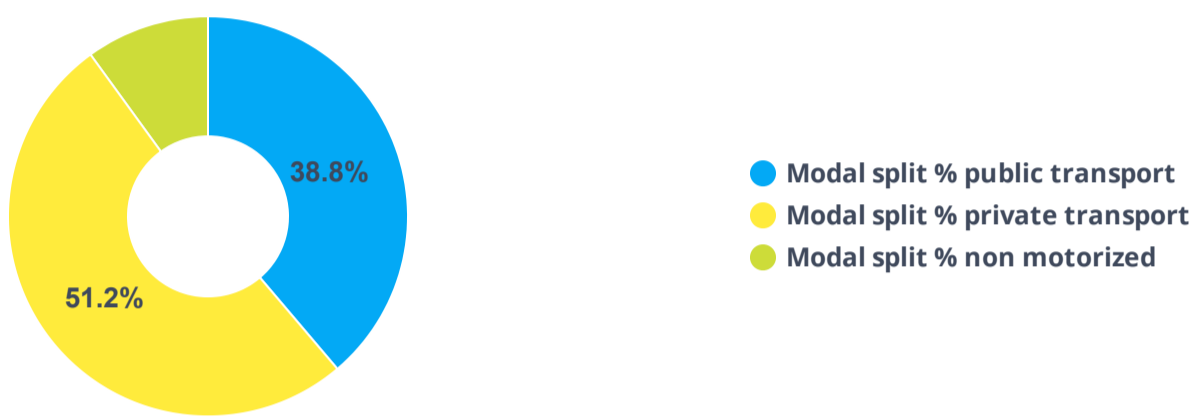

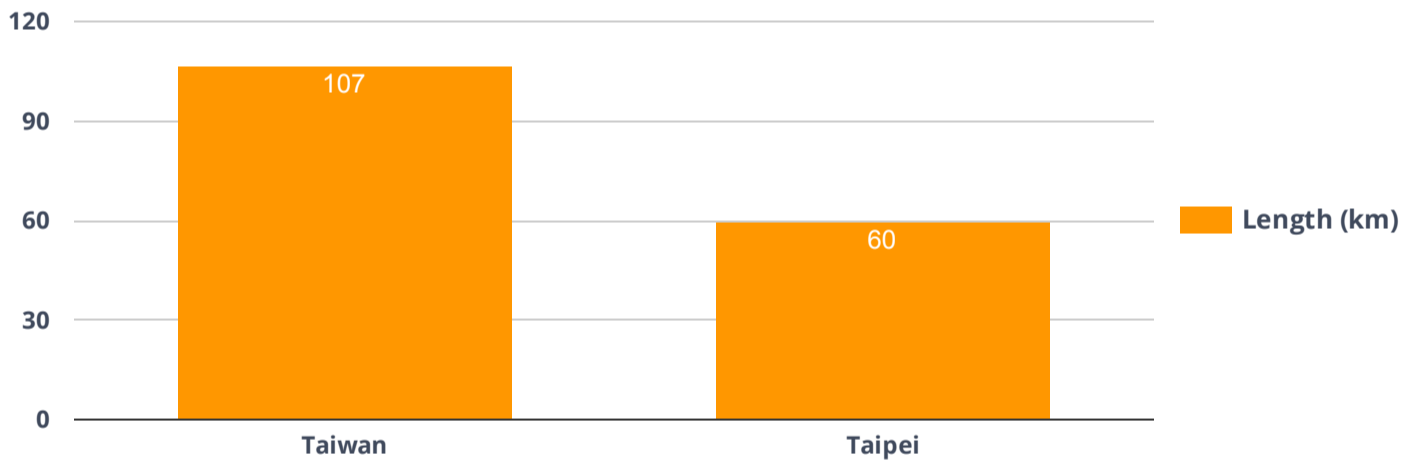
“ Taipei has **2,683,257** inhabitants. **38,8%** of total trips are made by public transport, as showed in the graph below.

MODAL SPLIT - TAIPEI

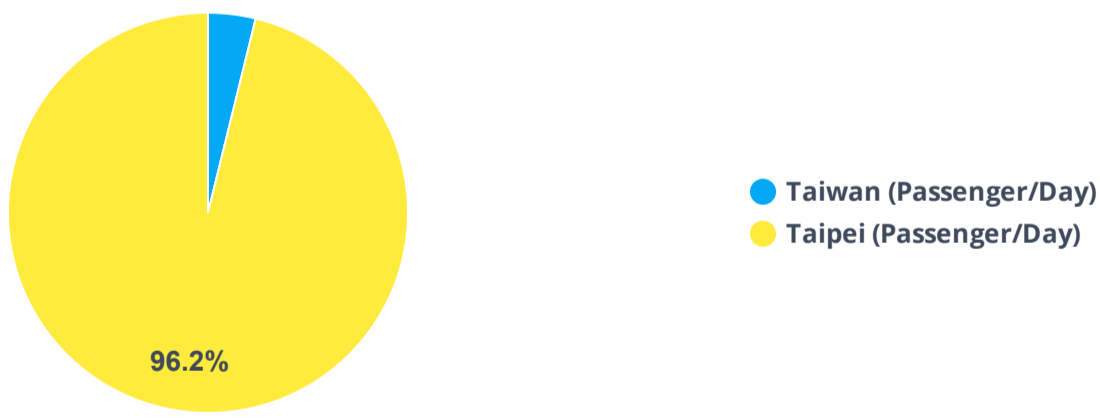


“ The city has started the system in **1998** and now counts with **1** bus priority corridors consisting of **60** kilometers and benefiting **1,302,832** passengers every day. The average operational speed of the system is **19,5** km/h.
