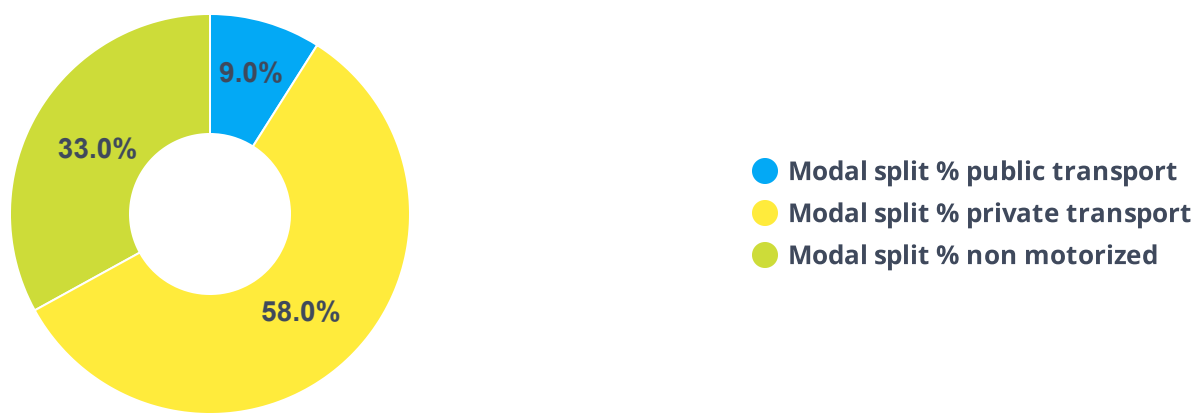


LILLE, FRANCE - LIANE



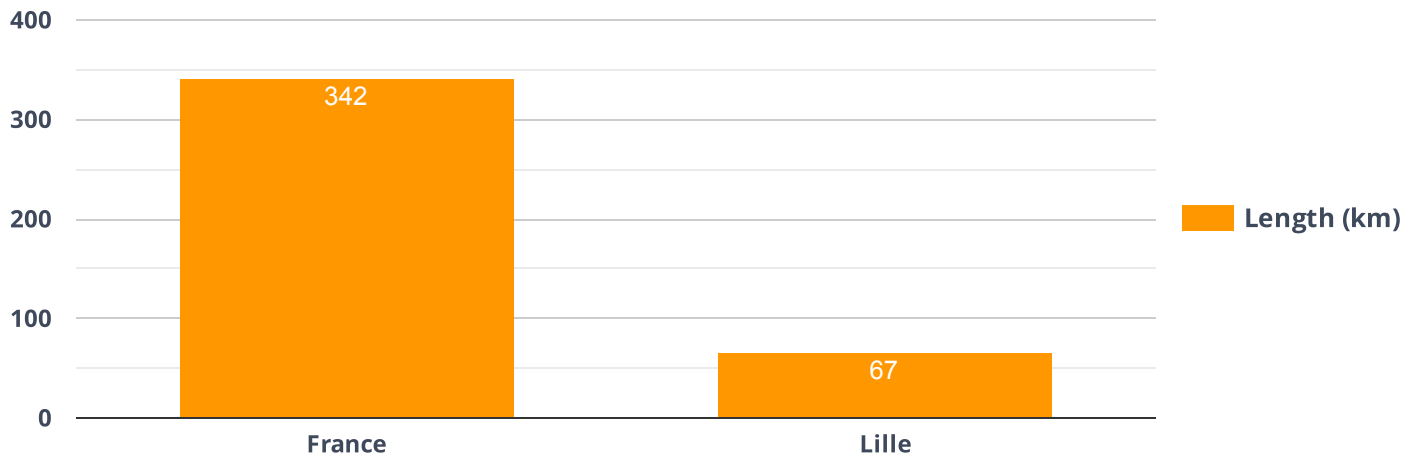
“ Lille has **227,560** inhabitants. **9%** of total trips are made by public transport, as showed in the graph below.

MODAL SPLIT - LILLE

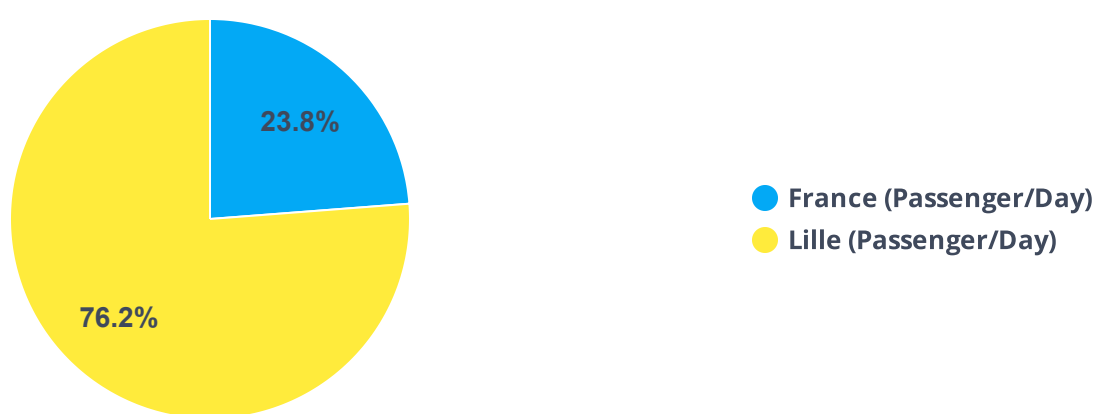


“ The city has started the system in **2008** and now counts with **3** bus priority corridors consisting of **67** kilometers and benefiting **1,317,000** passengers every day. The average operational speed of the system is **13** km/h.
