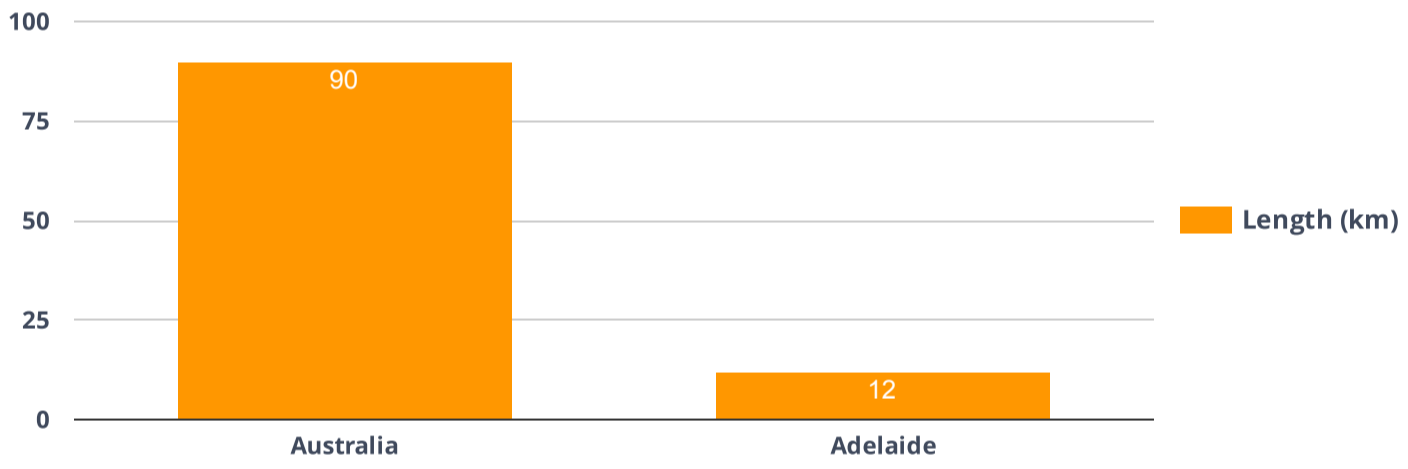
“ **Adelaide** has **1,168,000** inhabitants. **10.2%** of total trips are made by public transport, as showed in the graph below.

MODAL SPLIT - ADELAIDE

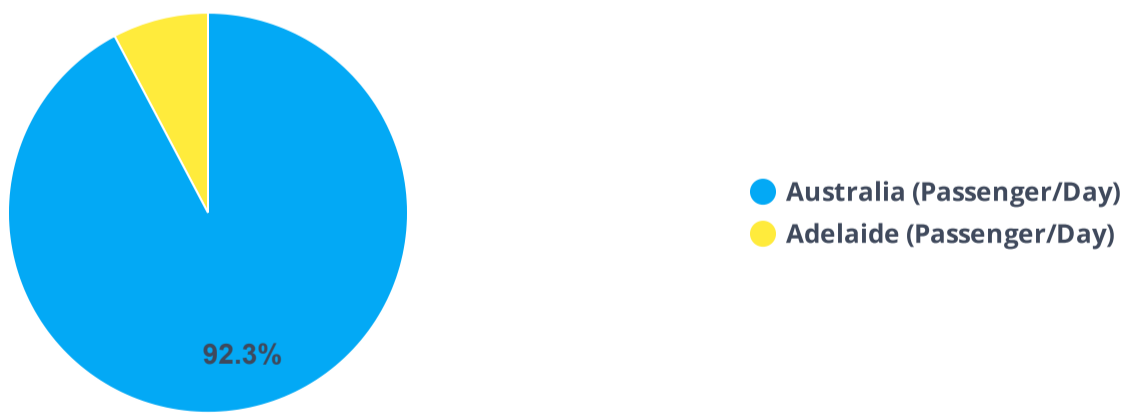


“ The city has started the system in **1986** and now counts with **1** bus priority corridors consisting of **12** kilometers and benefiting **32,000** passengers every day. The average operational speed of the system is **80** km/h.
