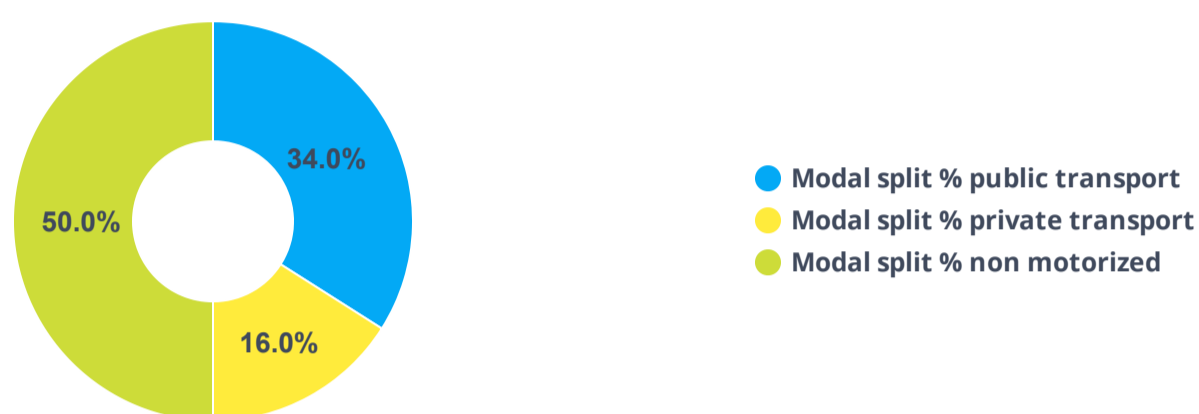

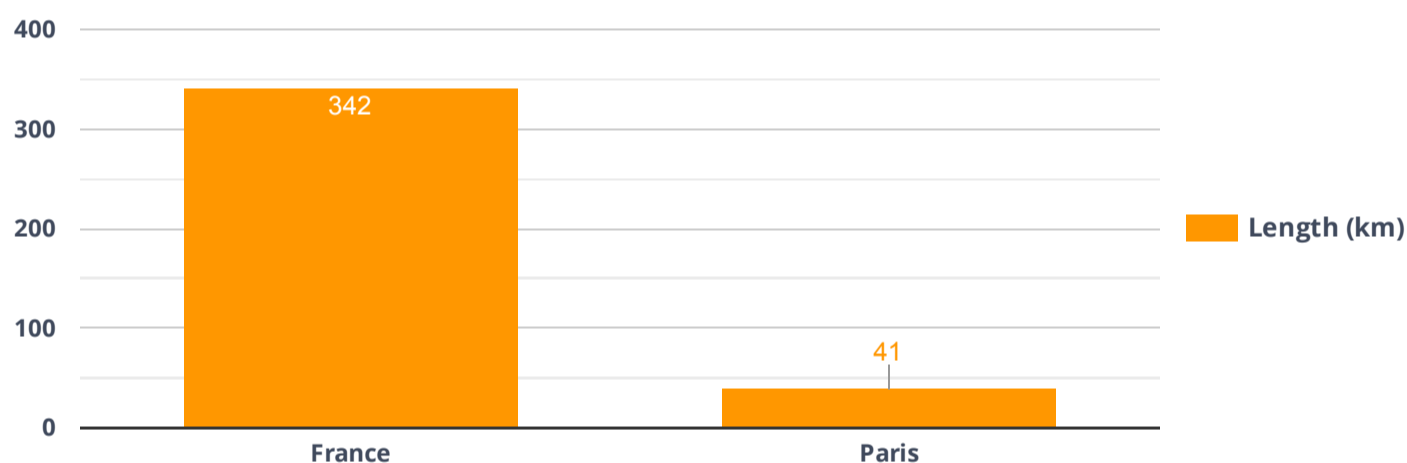
“ Paris has **2,206,488** inhabitants. **34%** of total trips are made by public transport, as showed in the graph below.

MODAL SPLIT - PARIS

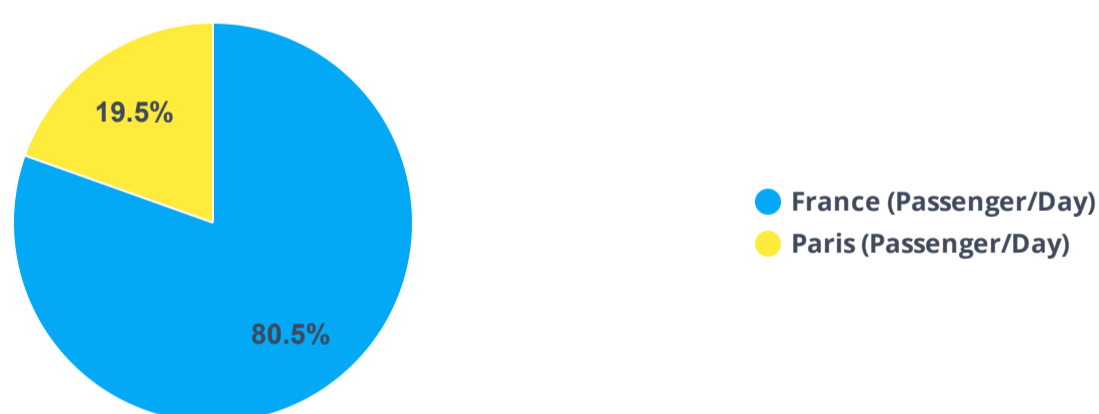


“ The city has started the system in **1993** and now counts with **3** bus priority corridors consisting of **41** kilometers and benefiting **89,500** passengers every day. The average operational speed of the system is **23,5** km/h.
