“**Stockholm** has **889,501** inhabitants. **35%** of total trips are made by public transport, as showed in the graph below.

“The city has started the system in **1998** and now counts with **1** bus priority corridors consisting of **40** kilometers and benefiting **57,000** passengers every day. The average operational speed of the system is **16.5** km/h.
