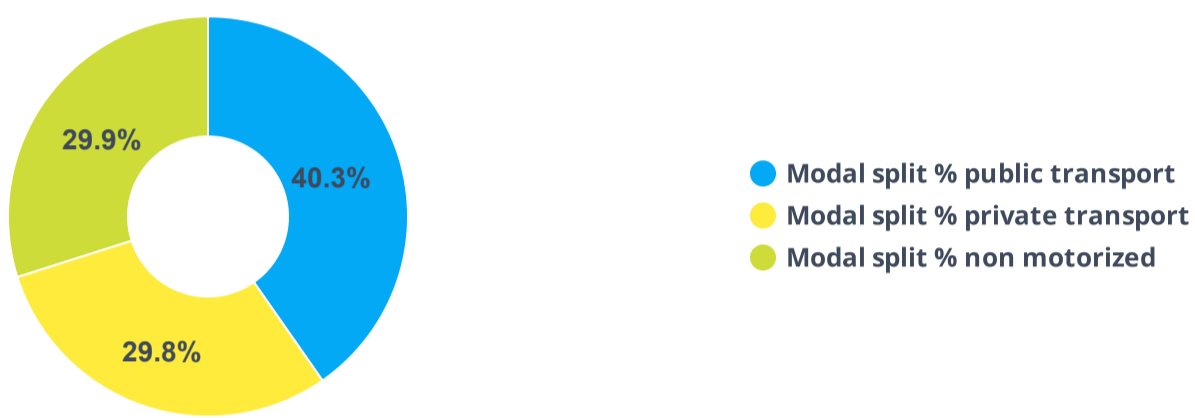


**CÓRDOBA, ARGENTINA - SOLO BUS**



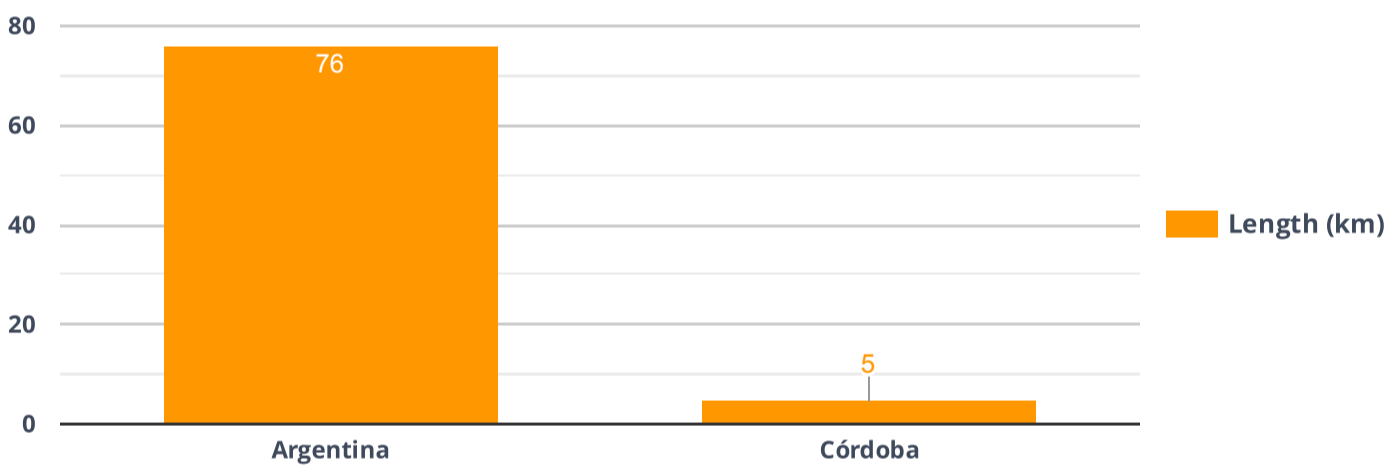
“ **Córdoba** has **1,329,604** inhabitants. **40,3%** of total trips are made by public transport, as showed in the graph below.

MODAL SPLIT - CÓRDOBA

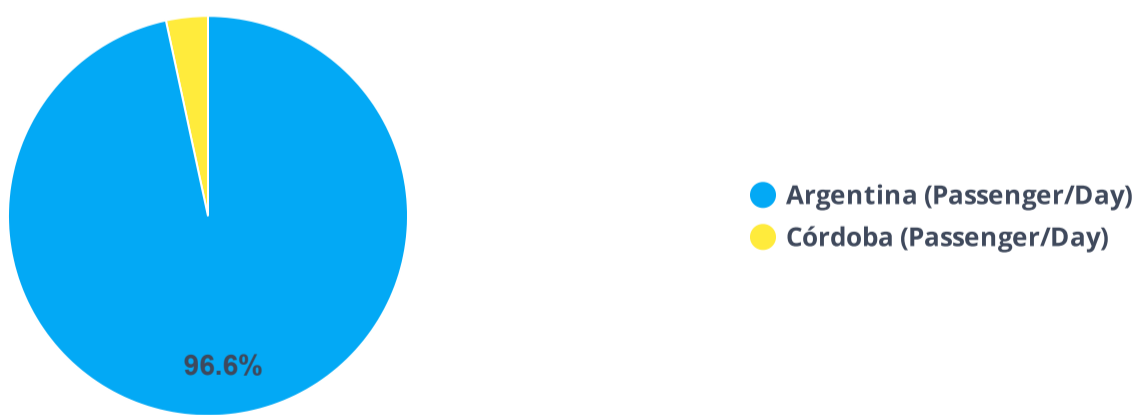


“ The city has started the system in **2014** and now counts with **1** bus priority corridors consisting of **5** kilometers and benefiting **58,000** passengers every day.
