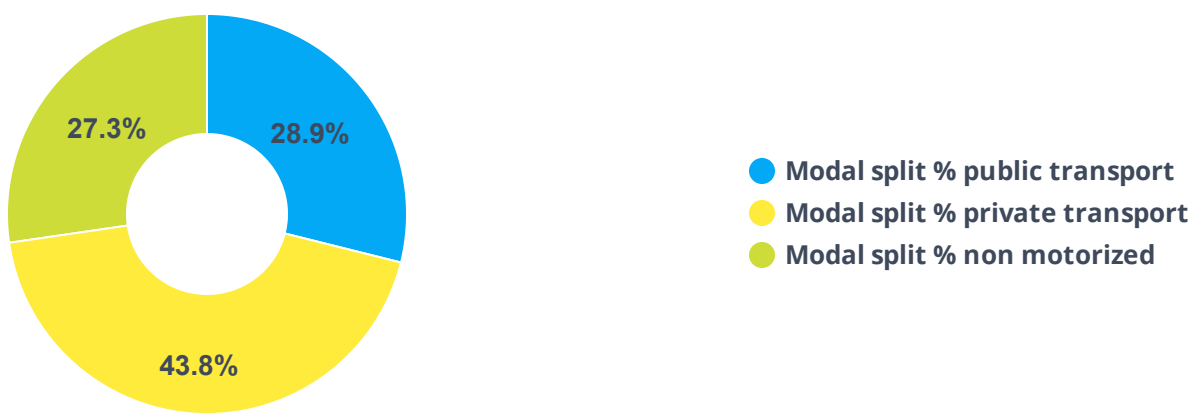


CAMPINAS, BRAZIL - SISTEMA INTERCAMP



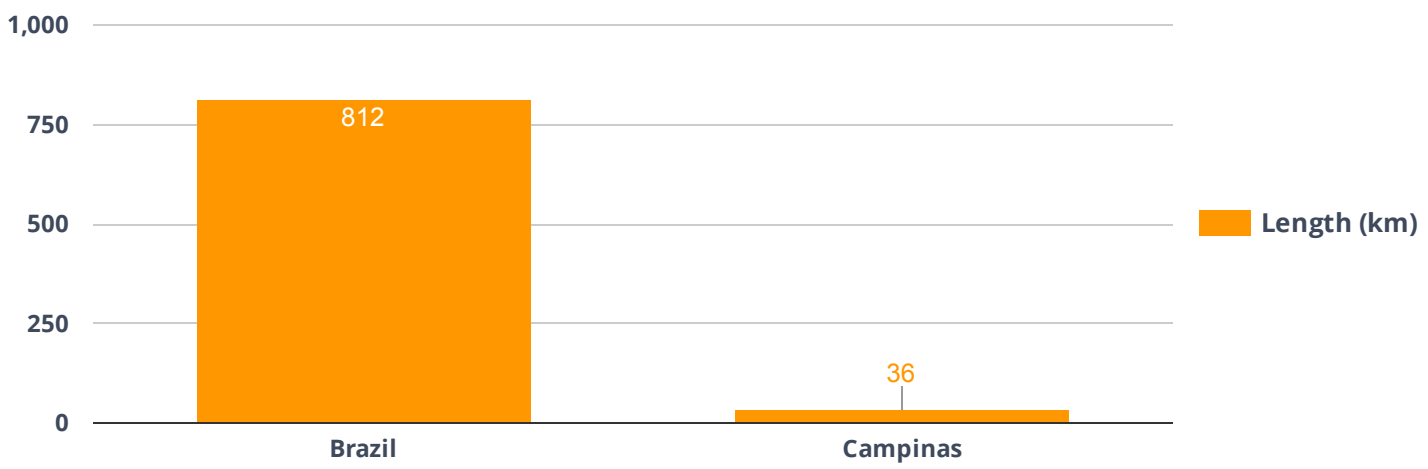
“ **Campinas** has **1,213,792** inhabitants. **28,9%** of total trips are made by public transport, as showed in the graph below.

MODAL SPLIT - CAMPINAS

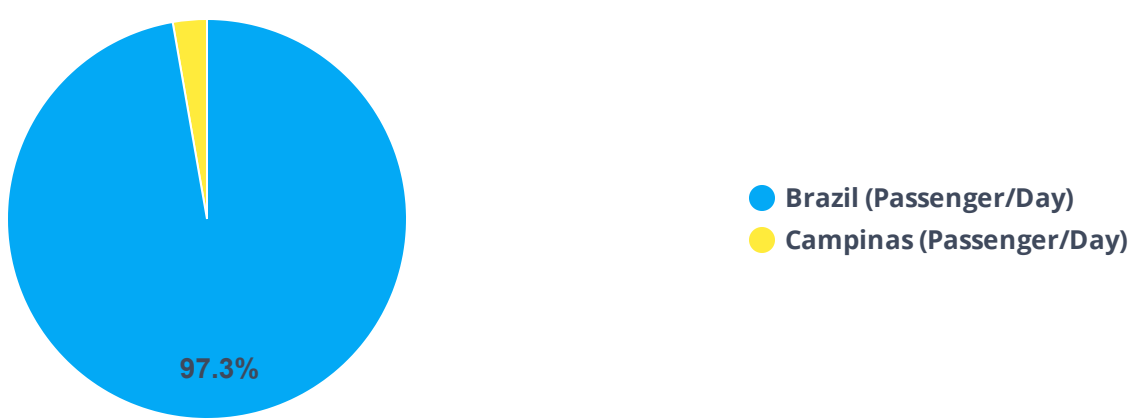


“ The city has started the system in **1986** and now counts with **3** bus priority corridors consisting of **35** kilometers and benefiting **295,000** passengers every day.
