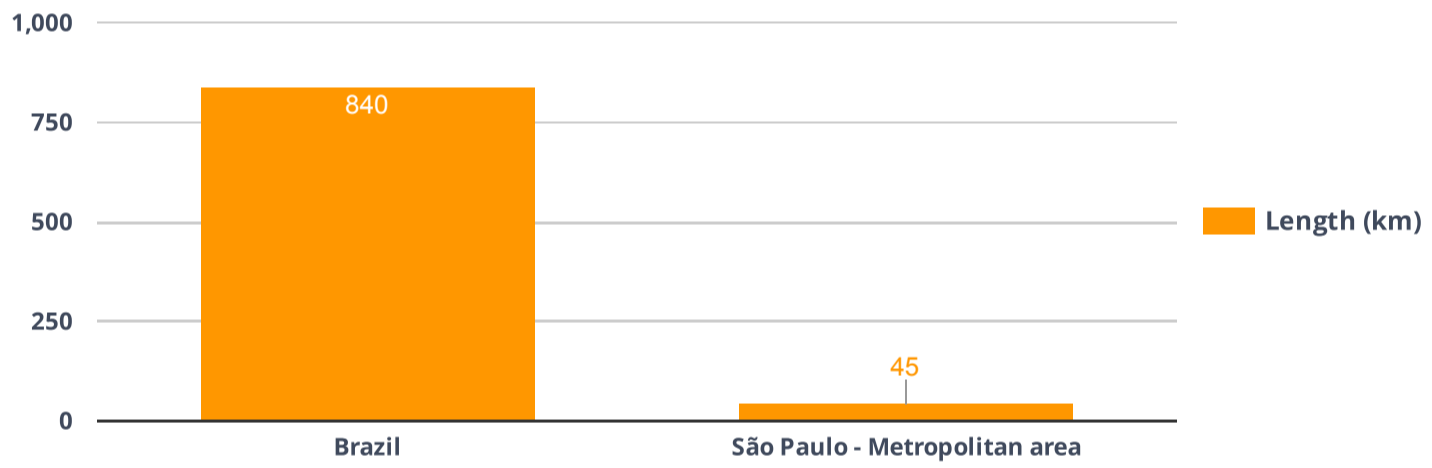
“ **São Paulo - Metropolitan area** has **14,360,674** inhabitants. **36,8%** of total trips are made by public transport, as showed in the graph below.

MODAL SPLIT - SÃO PAULO - METROPOLITAN AREA

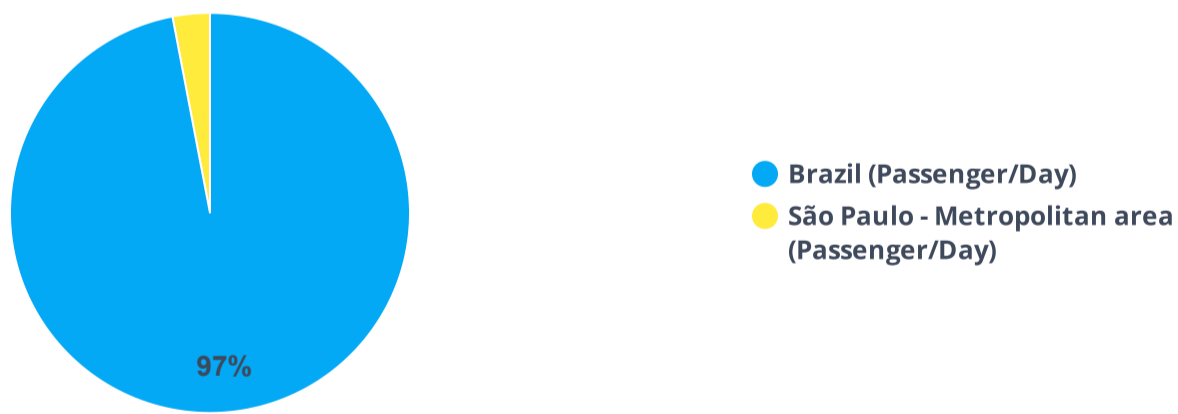


“ The city has started the system in **1988** and now counts with **2** bus priority corridors consisting of **45** kilometers and benefiting **325,000** passengers every day. The average operational speed of the system is **21,0** km/h.
