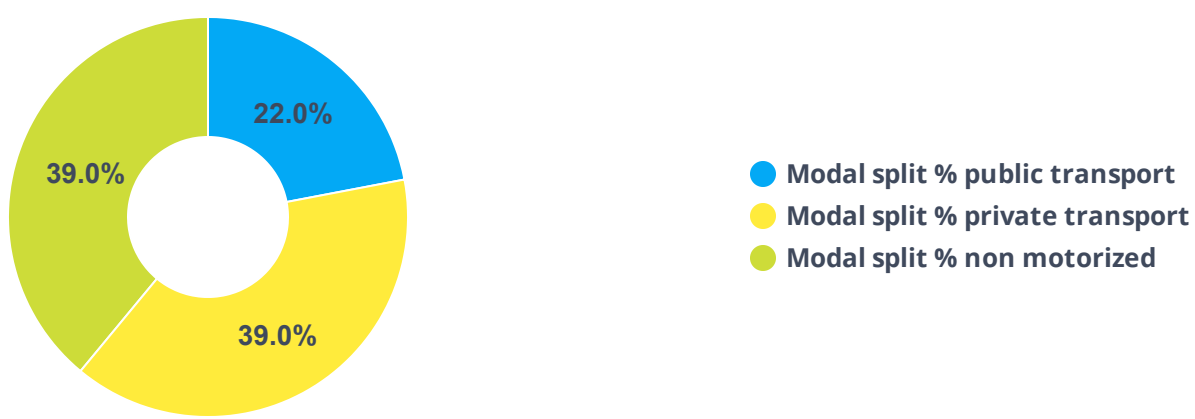


SUMARÉ, BRAZIL



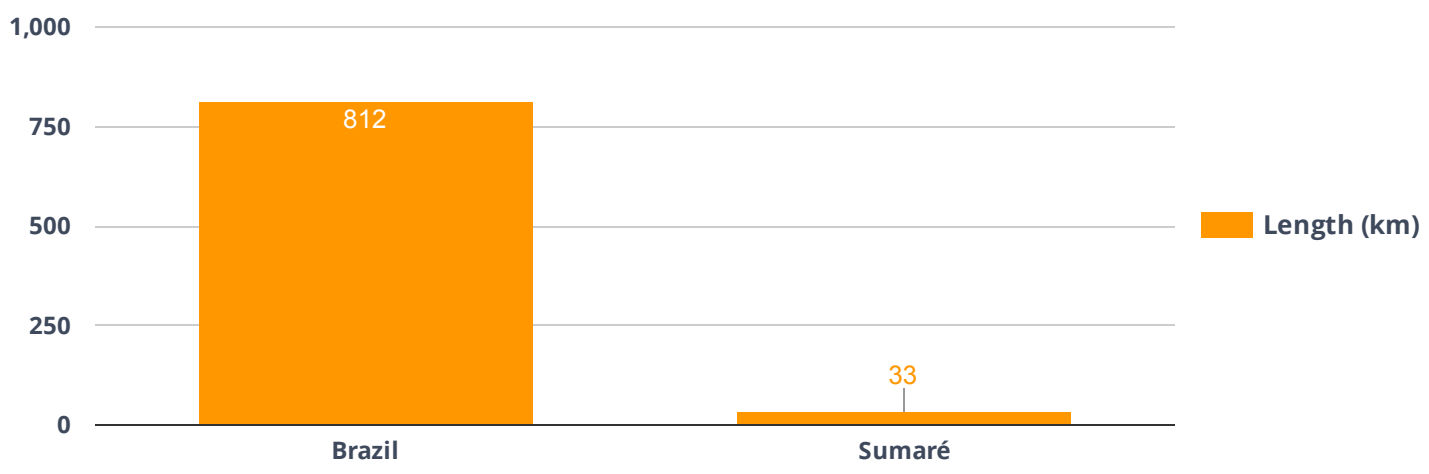
“ Sumaré has **265,955** inhabitants. **22%** of total trips are made by public transport, as showed in the graph below.

MODAL SPLIT - SUMARÉ

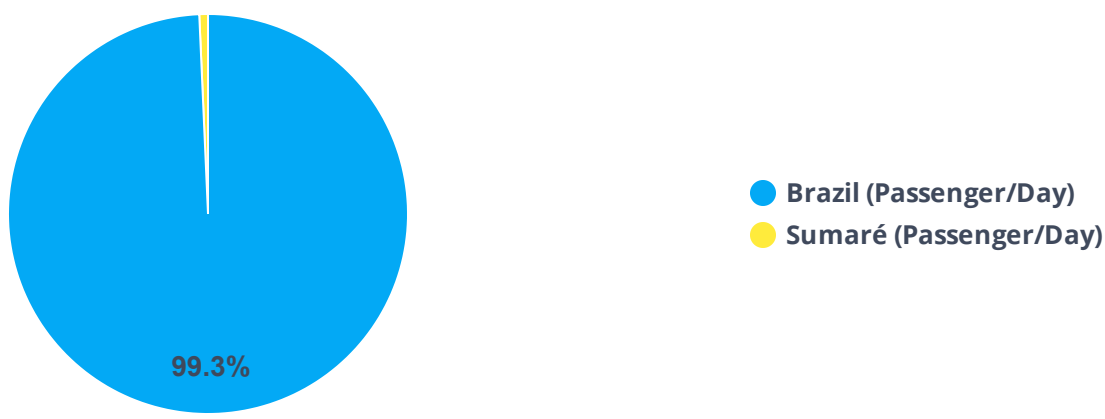


“ The city has started the system in **2010** and now counts with **1** bus priority corridors consisting of **32** kilometers and benefiting **75,000** passengers every day.
