“Guadalajara has **1,494,134** inhabitants. **28%** of total trips are made by public transport, as showed in the graph below.

“The city has started the system in **2009** and now counts with **1** bus priority corridors consisting of **16** kilometers and benefiting **127,000** passengers every day. The average operational speed of the system is **28** km/h.
