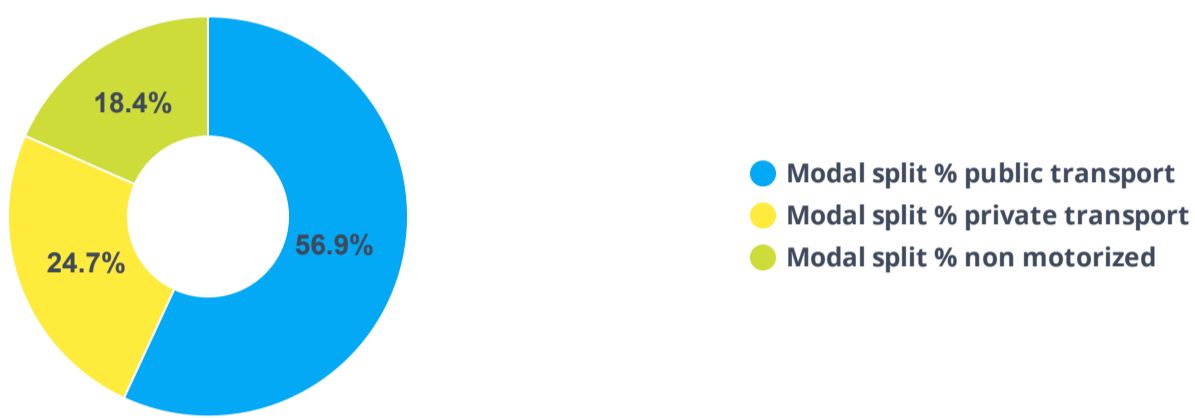


CARACAS, VENEZUELA - BUSCARACAS



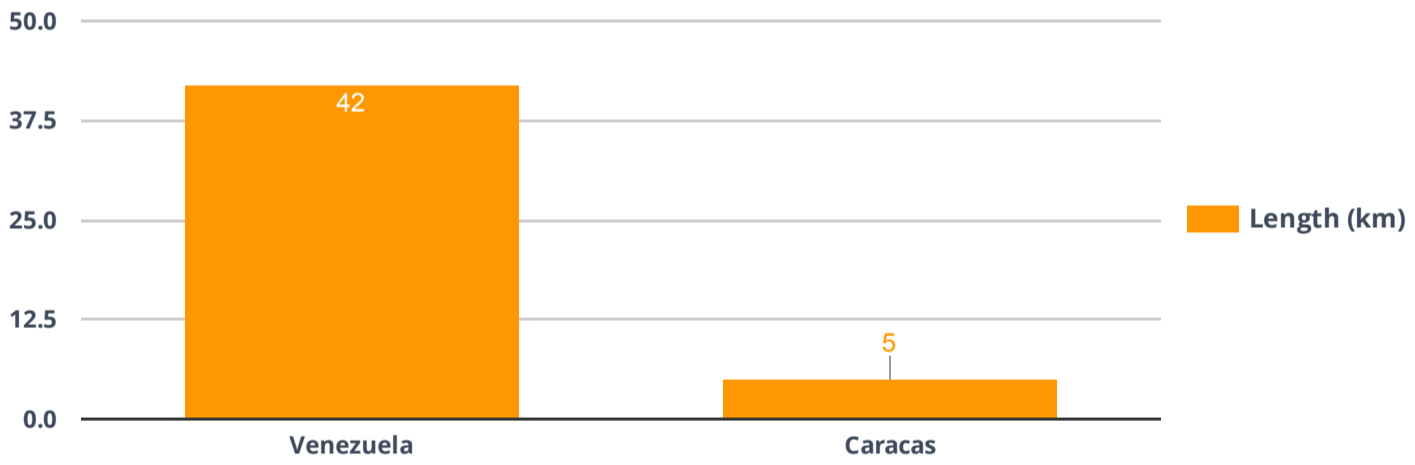
“ **Caracas** has **1,943,901** inhabitants. **56,9%** of total trips are made by public transport, as showed in the graph below.

MODAL SPLIT - CARACAS

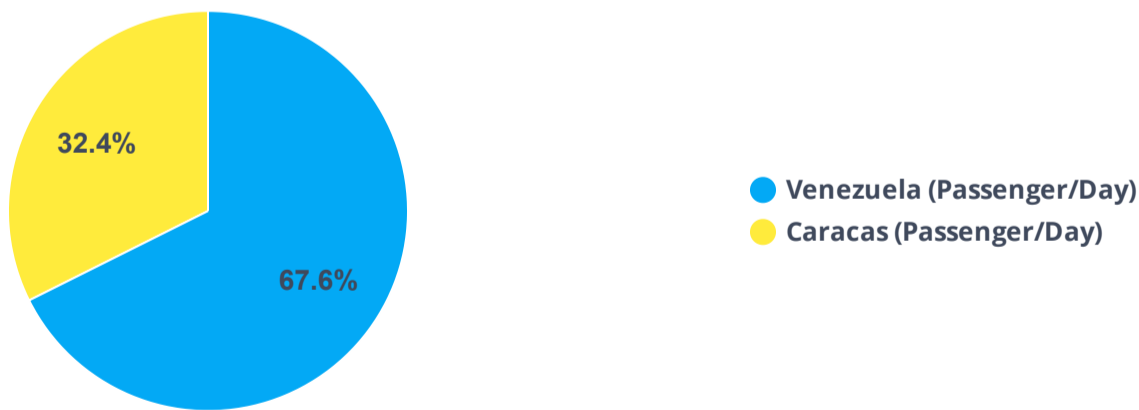


“ The city has started the system in **2012** and now counts with **1** bus priority corridors consisting of **5** kilometers and benefiting **77,948** passengers every day.
