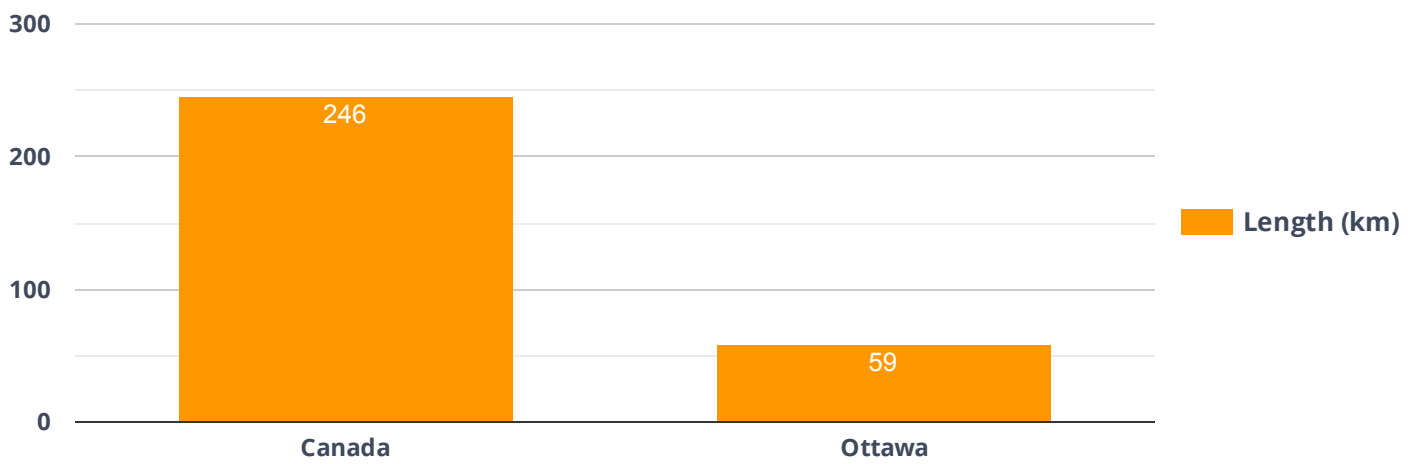
“ **Ottawa** has **951,727** inhabitants. **19%** of total trips are made by public transport, as showed in the graph below.

MODAL SPLIT - OTTAWA

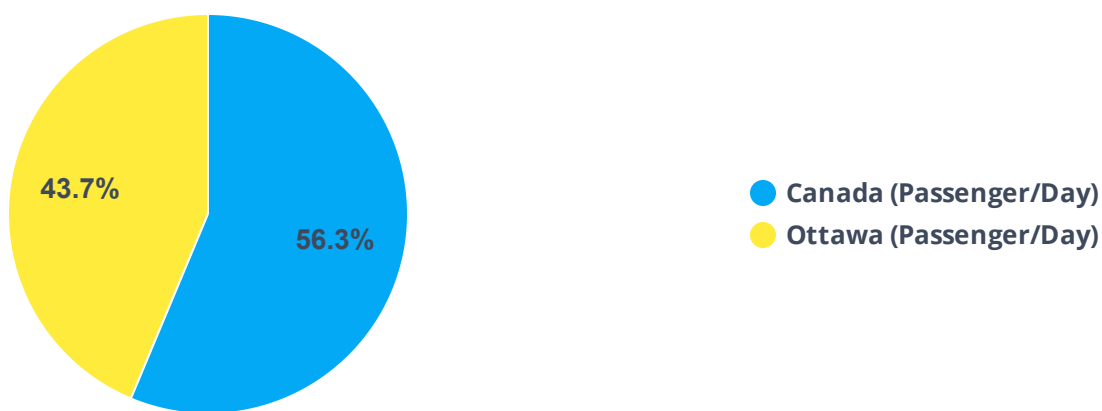


“ The city has started the system in **1983** and now counts with **5** bus priority corridors consisting of **58** kilometers and benefiting **220,000** passengers every day. The average operational speed of the system is **45** km/h.
