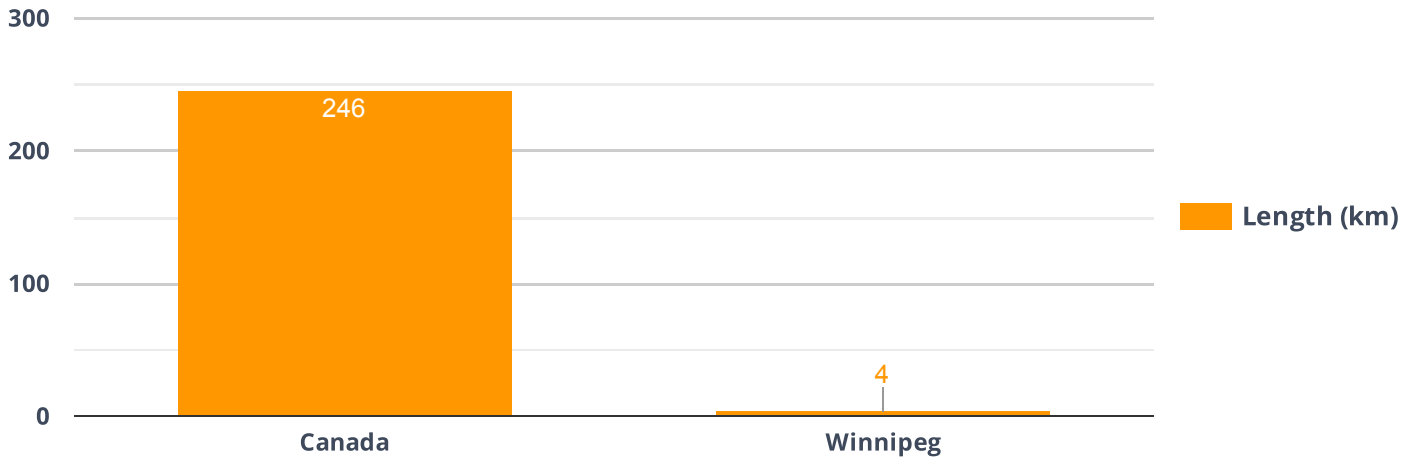
“ **Winnipeg** has **663,617** inhabitants. **13,0%** of total trips are made by public transport, as showed in the graph below.

MODAL SPLIT - WINNIPEG

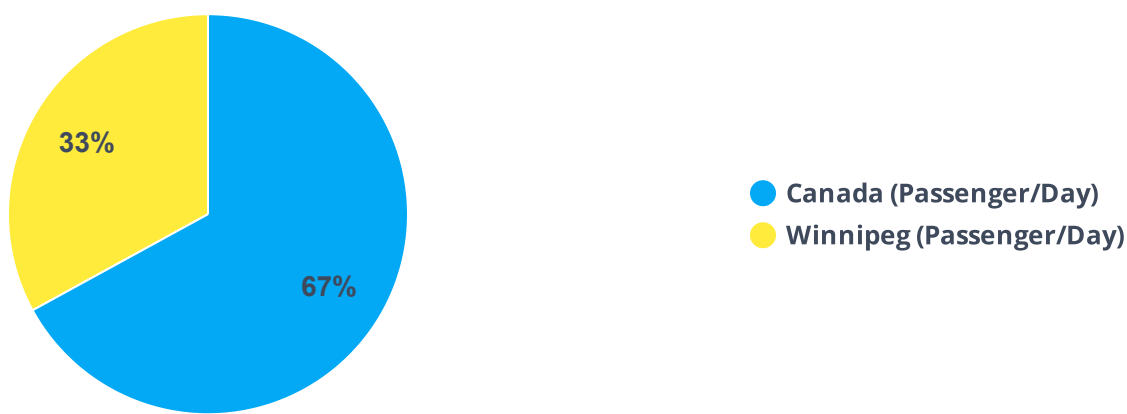


“ The city has started the system in **2012** and now counts with **1** bus priority corridors consisting of **3** kilometers and benefiting **166,000** passengers every day.
