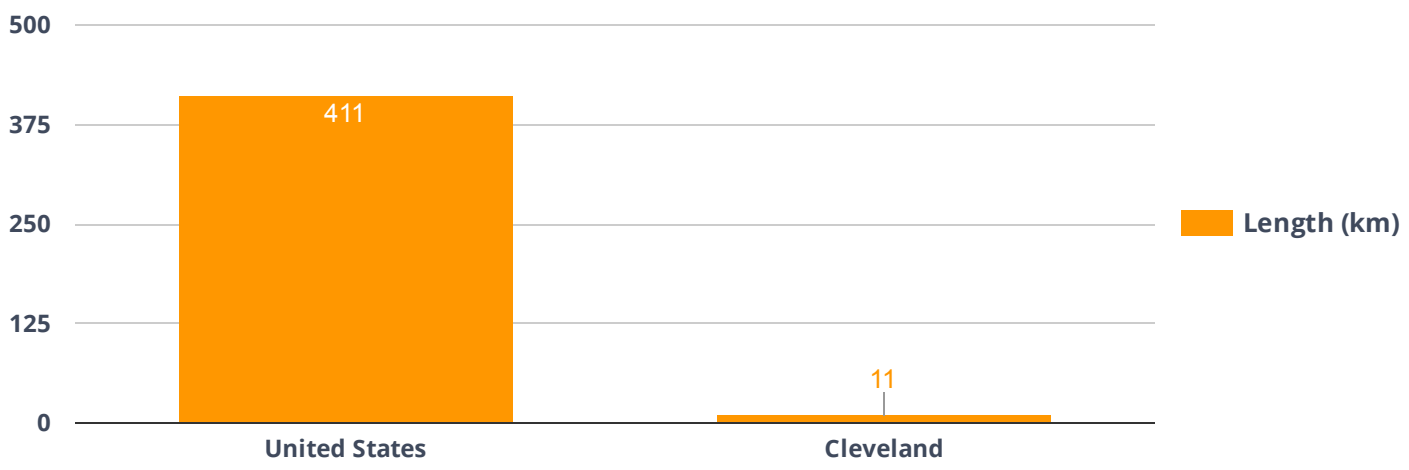
“ **Cleveland** has **396,815** inhabitants. **2%** of total trips are made by public transport, as showed in the graph below.

**MODAL SPLIT - CLEVELAND**

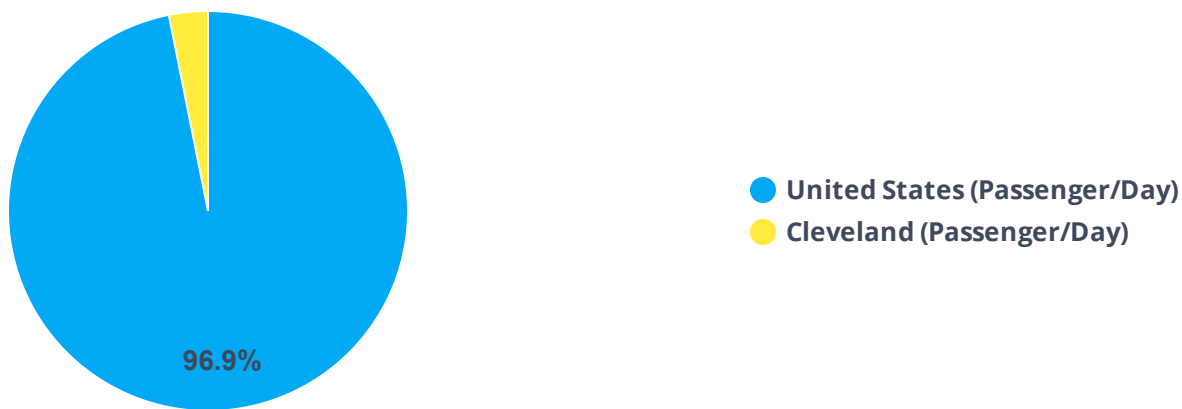
