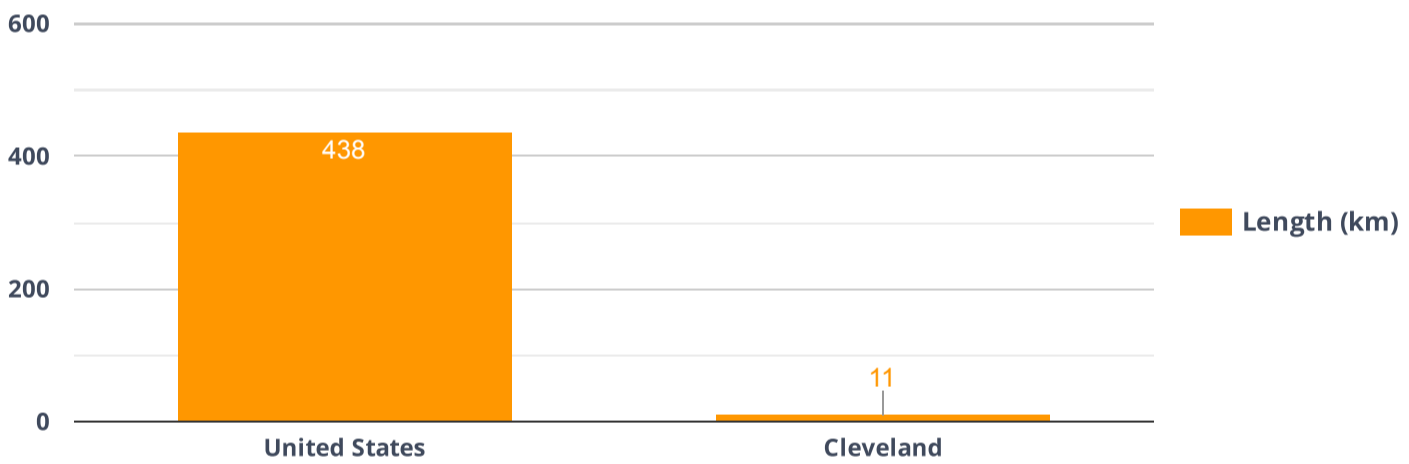
“ **Cleveland** has **396,815** inhabitants. **2%** of total trips are made by public transport, as showed in the graph below.

MODAL SPLIT - CLEVELAND

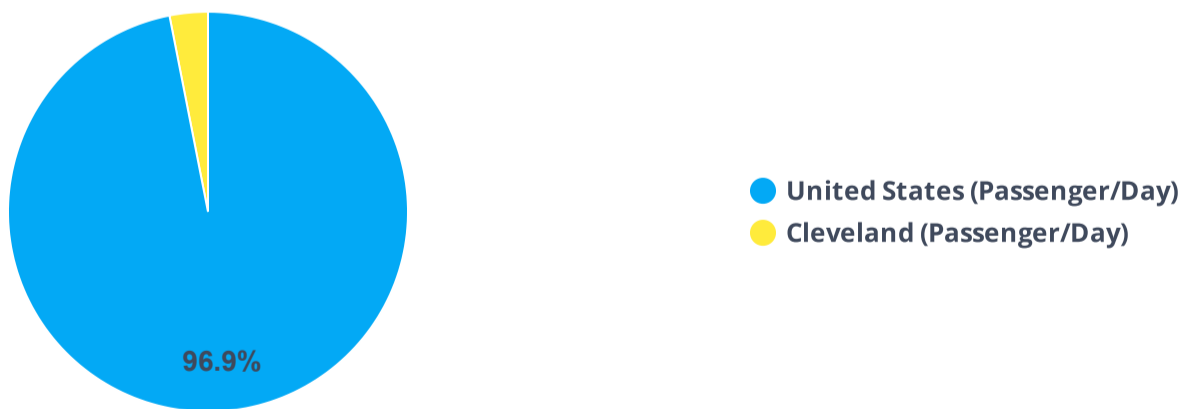


“ The city has started the system in **2009** and now counts with **1** bus priority corridors consisting of **11** kilometers and benefiting **15,000** passengers every day. The average operational speed of the system is **17,7** km/h.
