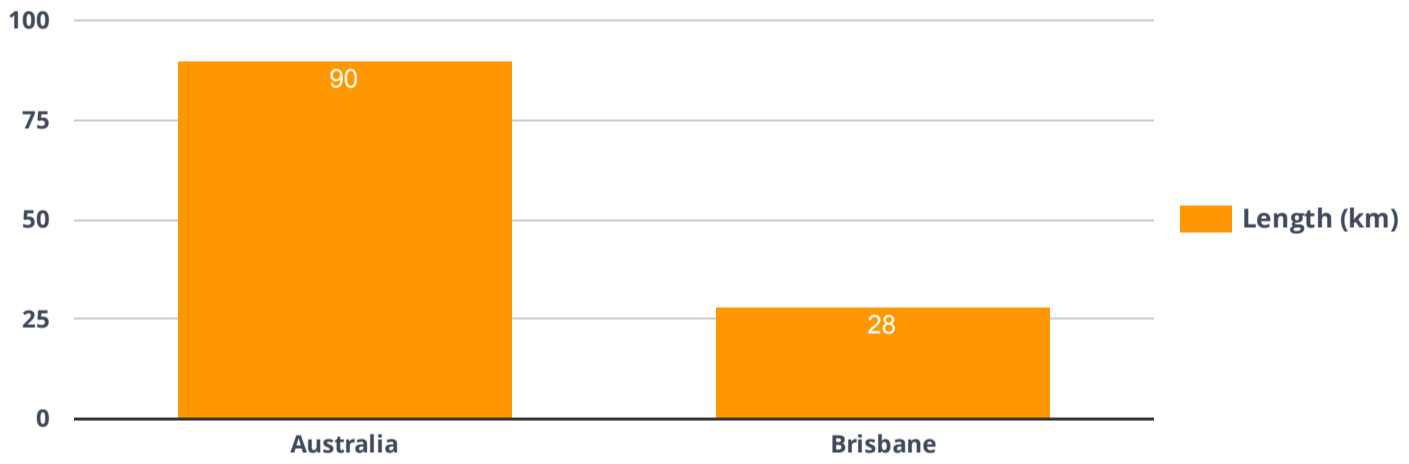
“ **Brisbane** has **1,970,000** inhabitants. **15%** of total trips are made by public transport, as showed in the graph below.

“ The city has started the system in **2000** and now counts with **3** bus priority corridors consisting of **28** kilometers and benefiting **356,800** passengers every day. The average operational speed of the system is **37,5** km/h.
