

**AUCKLAND, NEW ZEALAND - NORTHERN BUSWAY**



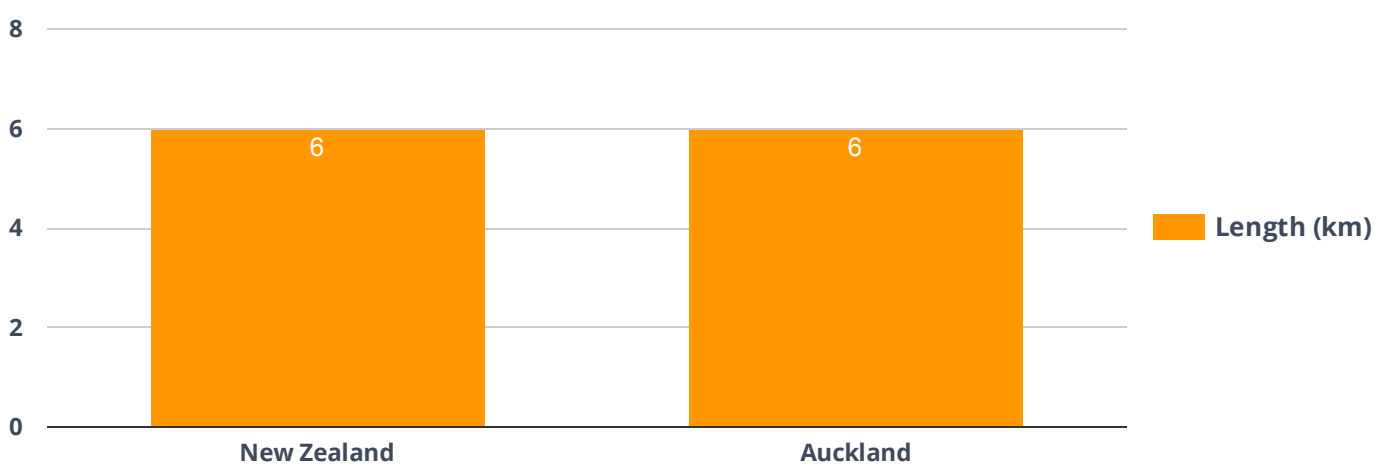
“ **Auckland** has **1,507,700** inhabitants. **4%** of total trips are made by public transport, as showed in the graph below.

“ The city has started the system in **2008** and now counts with **1** bus priority corridors consisting of **6** kilometers and benefiting **22,900** passengers every day. The average operational speed of the system is **31,0** km/h.
